On 2/19/2009 I was assigned to Salem Hospital Watch 1st Shift Room B5134 housing solely Inmate Michael Hill SID#12996424. Throughout the night Inmate Hill had a distinctive breathing pattern that could be heard from several feet away. At approximately 5:05 I noticed his breathing had changed. His breathing had a distinctive gasping sound that I could no longer hear. I could not tell visually if Inmate Hill was breathing so I immediately notified RN Kellie Lombardi who had been sitting right outside the door to come in and examine inmate Hill immediately. She entered the room and examined him. She stated she could not tell if his heart had stopped and had to get her stethoscope. She returned with RN Cheryl McIntosh, RN Joey Dixon to examine Inmate Hill. I contacted OIC LT James Taylor to advise him of the incidents taking place and while on the phone with LT Taylor the nurses pronounced Inmate Hill dead. I let LT Taylor know this as and he contacted the State Police. I advised the nurses in the room that this was now declared a crime scene and started my log accordingly letting them know that no one is to enter the room without being written in my log going forward to keep the area secured. I continued the Log and was relieved by CO J Stephenson at approximately 7:40. The Body was examined and released by Detective Scott Yunker at 8:50AM.

4. **Specific Information:** (Personal injury, property damage, notification of kin).

After nursing staff had pronounced him dead, the nurses immediately started to remove his IV, his [redacted] drip and "prepared" him "so his family could see him". I instructed them to back away from the bed and leave all items alone as this has to be a secured crime scene for the State Police to inspect undisturbed.

State police arrived. Lt J Taylor DIC called @

5:10 to advise on inmate passing. It took nursing staff approx 2 mins to declare inmate passed as they had to get a stethoscope and check for a heartbeat. Made a call to page parents as unsure if he had passed or was close. Nurse Kelly removed the IV and turned off pump in preparation for family to see him. Once declared a passed (while on phone waiting for DIC) room was declared a crime scene. Nurse Kelly was advised not to leave as the state police will need to speak with her. She understood but was very emotional that this is a hospital and he shouldn't have been treated this way. It is a cancer ward and the room should not be sealed off. ^{He had a long term illness} I advised her Mr Hill is an inmate and this room is now a crime scene. We are not dealing with normal citizen circumstances please comply with what I as an officer of the state and my boss Lt James Taylor of Oregon State Penitentiary needs you to do. She finished her notes (per Hosp policy and promptly exited. I advised her to stay right outside the door (to finish her work) as the state police were trying to speak to her upon their arrival. She took down my full name after I spelled it for her and advised her to start by (could not detain) Crime scene report started.
